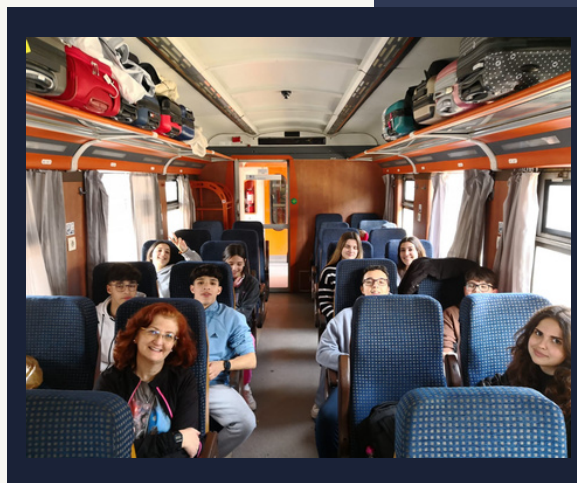




Rumania 21/4

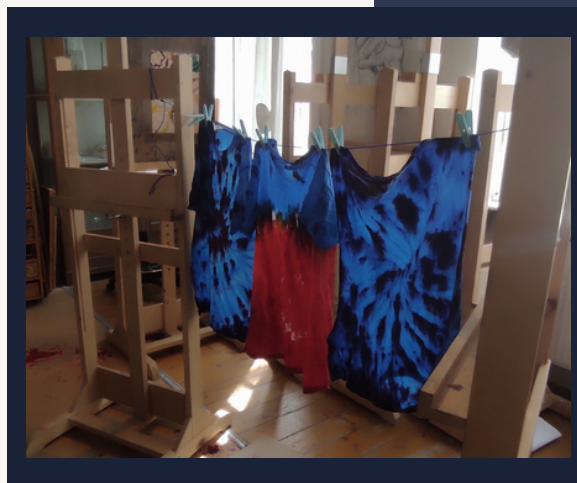
ORCHESTRA AND CHOIR

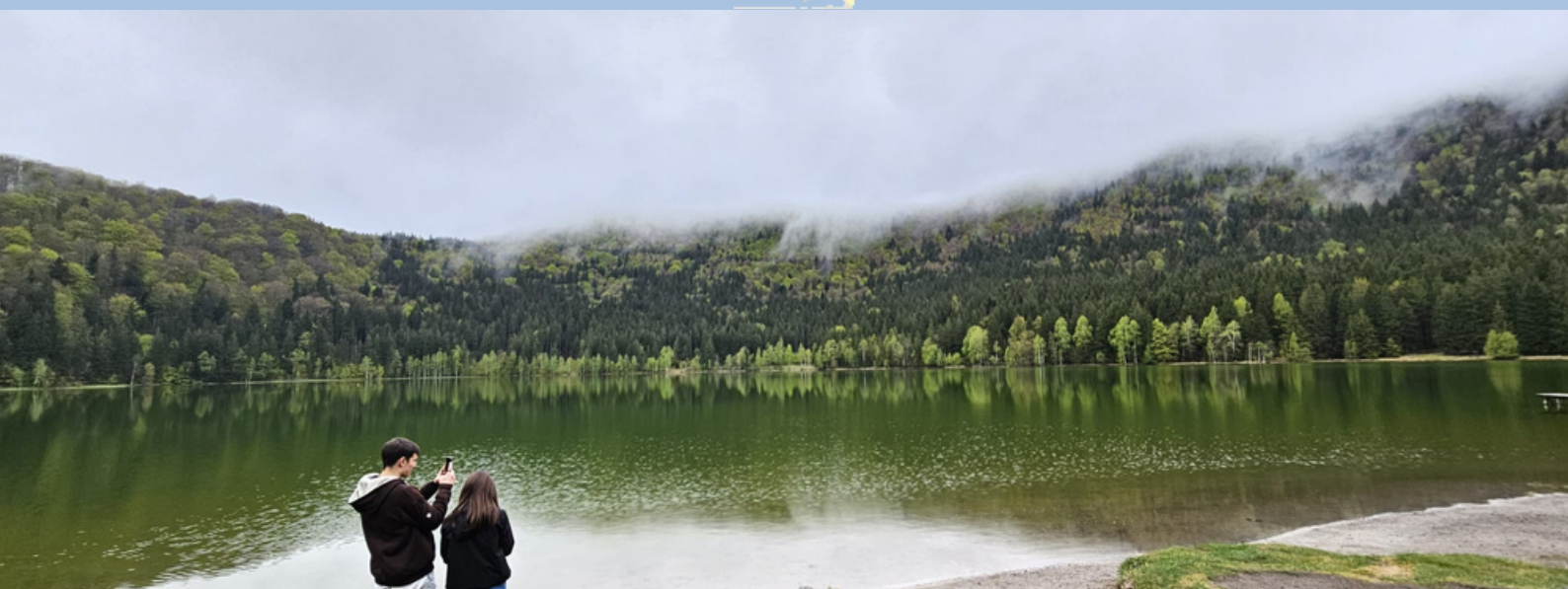
To start off the morning, at nine, the music students performed some pieces from the repertoire they had been rehearsing.

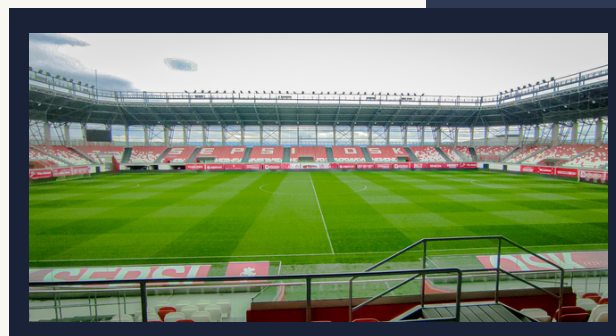
LOCAL BAKERY (DIÓSZEGI)

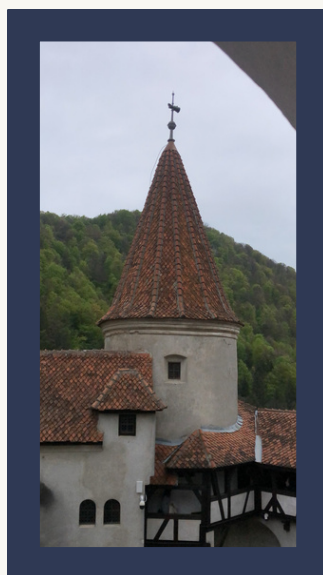
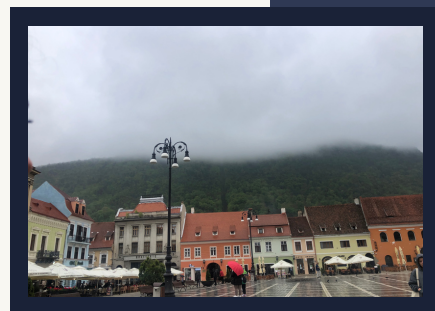
DAY 25

At the end of the day, very sad, we were able to enjoy the farewell dinner, which was delicious.





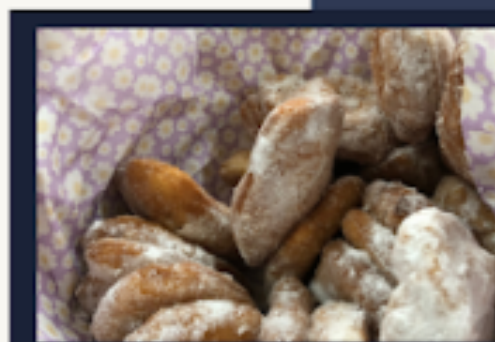
Romania Friday 26

We start the day with a typical Romanian sweet for breakfast.

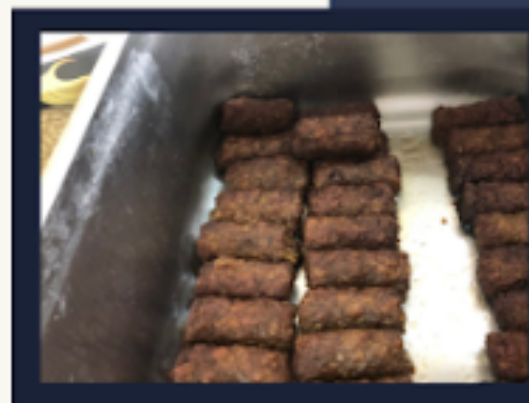
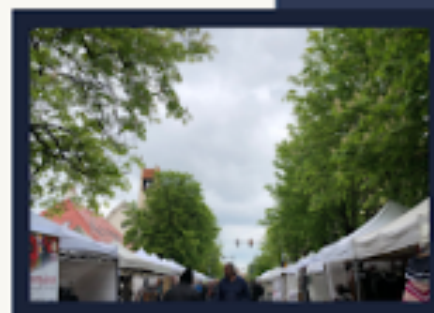
Afterwards we walked around a craft market.

We visited many churches Catholic and Orthodox, learning their differences.

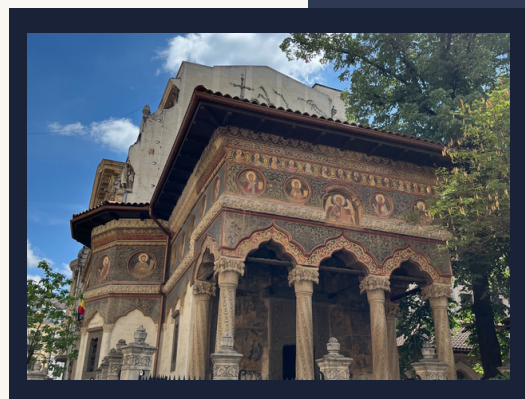
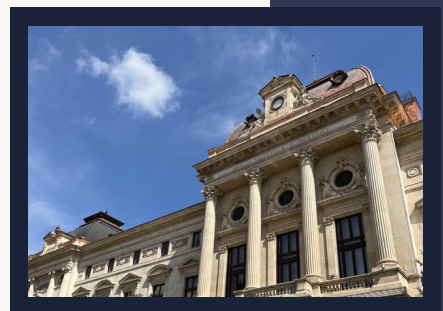
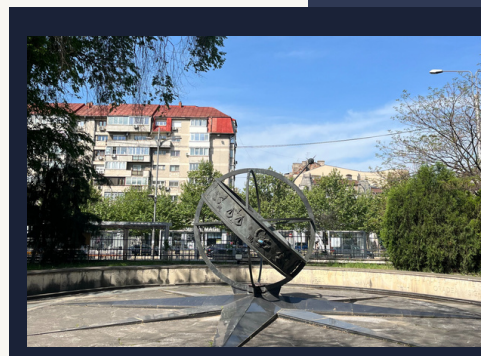
We also visited the zero kilometers of the country.
